
## Defining Reader's Advisory





## What Is Reader's Advisory?

A patroncentered library service for leisure readers.







## What Is Reader's Advisory?

Non-judgmental.









## What Is Reader's Advisory?

Driven by the belief that reading has intrinsic value.



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## Articulating a Book's Appeal




Appeal refers to how a book "feels," as opposed to what it's about.








**Not Genre**

Appeal consists of specific story elements:

- Pace
- Storyline
- Tone
- Character
- Writing Style








### Pacing

The rate at which the story unfolds

 MG begins slowly and increases pace toward the climax.






## Storyline

## The book's focus and structure

- Own voices: Silvia Moreno-Garcia is Mexican-Canadian. MC Noemi is Mexican.
- Intricately plotted






#### Tone

## The feeling the book evokes

- Creepy
- Menacing
- Atmospheric






#### Character

For readers who like certain types of characters

- Culturally diverse
- Strong female






## Writing Style

Complexity of language and level of detail

Compelling





#### **Other Considerations**

- Time
- Place
- Theme
- Similar Titles
- Genre/Subgenre

## Conducting the Reader's Advisory Interview



#### Start with This Question:

Can you tell me about a book you've read and enjoyed?



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#### Then Listen...

What story elements does the patron mention?



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### Suggest

Try to suggest at least 3 books the patron might like.



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#### Ask for Feedback

"Let me know how it goes!"

Use NoveListPlus to search by story elements and find similar books.

- Listen for appeal factors.

 RA is a patron-driven service in which library professionals help patrons find leisure reading materials.
